What are your responsibilities?

- A bedroom with a separate bed for the student that is neither convertible nor inflatable. Study space and/or area.
- 3 square meals a day.
- Some transportation.
- Guidance and assistance to your new family member, helping them to adapt to the American lifestyle.

What are your student's responsibilities?

- Sufficient command of the English language to succeed on the academic program.
- Sound academic history in their home country.
- A minimum of \$250.00 monthly spending money.
- Medical and accident insurance.
- Successful level of maturity to complete the program.
- Passport, travel documents and flight arrangements.

What are CETUSA's responsibilities?

- In cooperation with our overseas partners, we screen, accept and prepare the student for the program.
- Recruitment and training of Coordinators to assist you and your student throughout the program.
- Student & Host Family orientations.
- Regular contact with you, your student and the high school.
- Pre-departure and re-entry guidance.
- 24-hour emergency service via our toll-free telephone number.
