Interested students are encouraged to attend their program of choice for two years (junior and senior years).

Most programs require attendance at IVVC for 2 ¹/₂ hours either in the morning or afternoon depending on their choice of program (aviation mechanics require partial day attendance at Lewis University)

An informational meeting is typically held at YCS in the spring for current sophomores and juniors.

Families whose student is accepted into an IVVC program may be required to pay separate tuition from YCS and will be billed through YCS.

There may be additional program fees required from IVVC depending on the program selected.
